

AGE

All students entering kindergarten must have attained the age of five on or before September 1 of the current year.

All students entering first grade must have reached the age of six on or before September 1 of current year.

Students twenty-one (21) years of age prior to or on the opening day of school in the school year in which they apply for admission will not be admitted.

Any child who transfers from an out-of-state public or private school in which that state's law provides for a first grade enrollment date subsequent to September 1, shall be allowed to enroll if

- (a) The parent, legal guardian or custodian of such child was a legal resident of the state from which the child is transferring;
- (b) The out-of-state school from which the child is transferring is duly accredited by that state's appropriate accrediting authority;
- (c) Such child was legally enrolled in a public or private school for a minimum of four (4) weeks in
